Auditory

1. Number of students in Jack's class = 32

Number of students in Ira's class = 46

The total number of students in both the class = $32 + 46 = 78$

There are 78 students in Jack's and Ira's classes combined.

Word Problems

4. a. Number of stamps imprinted by Chang in a year = 2056

Number of stamps imprinted by Chang in the summer holidays = 987

Total number of stamps imprinted by Chang = $2056 + 987 = 3043$

Chang imprinted 3043 stamps in all.

- b. Toys produced by the factory in the 1st month = 2961

Toys produced by the factory in the 3rd month = 3812

Total toys produced by the factory in 3 months =

$2961 + 2768 + 3812 = 9541$

The factory produced 9541 toys in the three months.
